



**THE ELISABETH GOOD FELLOWSHIP**  
**Teacher Professional Development Program**  
**2022 PROGRAM APPLICATION**

A Fellowship Program was set up through the establishment of a Trust Fund, a gift from Elisabeth Good, to provide monetary incentive for teachers to pursue graduate study in school administration. The underlying objective of the Fellowship Program is to perpetuate the philosophy that the ratio of male/female administrators becomes more similar to the ratio that exists in the teaching staff. Encouragement of more candidates for administrative positions is the expected outcome of this fellowship program.

The fund has more than doubled in the time since its inception with eleven hundred dollars in 1985. In the interim, the principal and some gifts have accrued interest that has financed over 55 scholarships from 1985-2018. In March, 2009, management of the Fund was transferred from the Franklin Township Community School Corporation to the Franklin Township Education Foundation. The monies have been invested in the Central Indiana Community Fund as a separate program from the FTEF endowment.

Applicants must hold a professional certificate in elementary or secondary education and have five years of teaching experience. The following criteria will be the basis for selection: commitment to children, leadership potential, organizational skills, and personal and career goals.

The graduate study may be accomplished at the college or university of the recipient's choice as a part-time or full-time student.

**Completed applications must be submitted by March 14, 2022.**

The FTEF Grant Committee reviews all applications.

Committee recommendations are submitted to the FTEF BOD for approval.

Winning candidates are notified by May 1, 2022.
